

Eyeglasses Referral & Prescription Assistance Programs

Terry was a Lake County resident who had been homeless for six months. In April 2007 he came to Lifeline for help purchasing his medications because he couldn't afford to buy them. He also applied for assistance in obtaining eyeglasses.
